Dear Joe,

In the remaining three weeks prior to the presidential elections, the Movimiento por Nicaragua (MpN) faces a critical stage of the campaign which requires increasing our efforts and resources in the production and distribution of Get-Out-The-Vote (GOTV) distribution of flyers, door to door visits, allocation of posters and banners in strategic high citizen mobility areas, distribution of products such as aprons, hats, bags, cintillos, bracelets, t-shirts, coordination of marches/demonstrations, among others.

Additionally, we are also currently airing a media campaign through all outlets where the Advertising Agency has been kind enough to air these messages without having paid the initially 50% required to release it through the media. However, they have requested that we submit the initial amount by this Friday considering our situation.

The MpN is conducting nation wide 90 activities per week with the support of our network of volunteers and activists.

Considering that the promotion activities will be intensified by the MpN due to the proximity of the elections, we kindly request for the second drawdown corresponding to the second phase to be sent for a total of US\$100,000 instead of the US\$70,000 that was originally contemplated in the drawdown calendar.

Below is a detail budget indicates how the drawdown for \$100,000 will be executed:
